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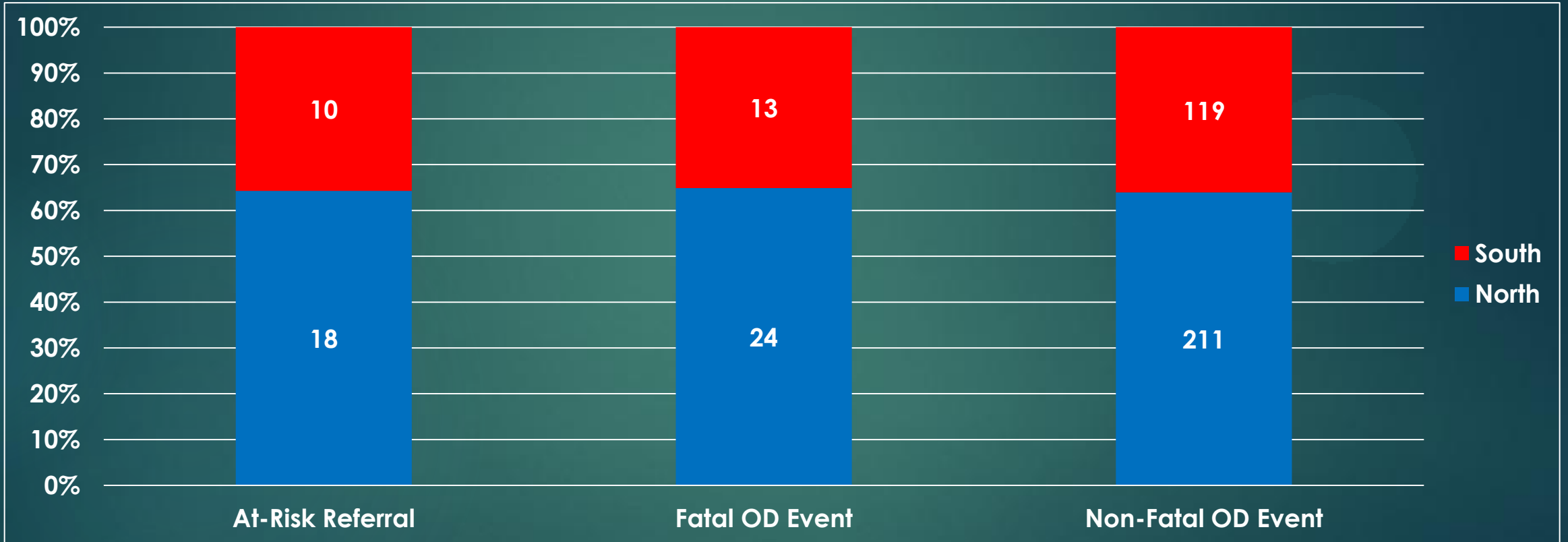

1/1/18 – 3/31/18

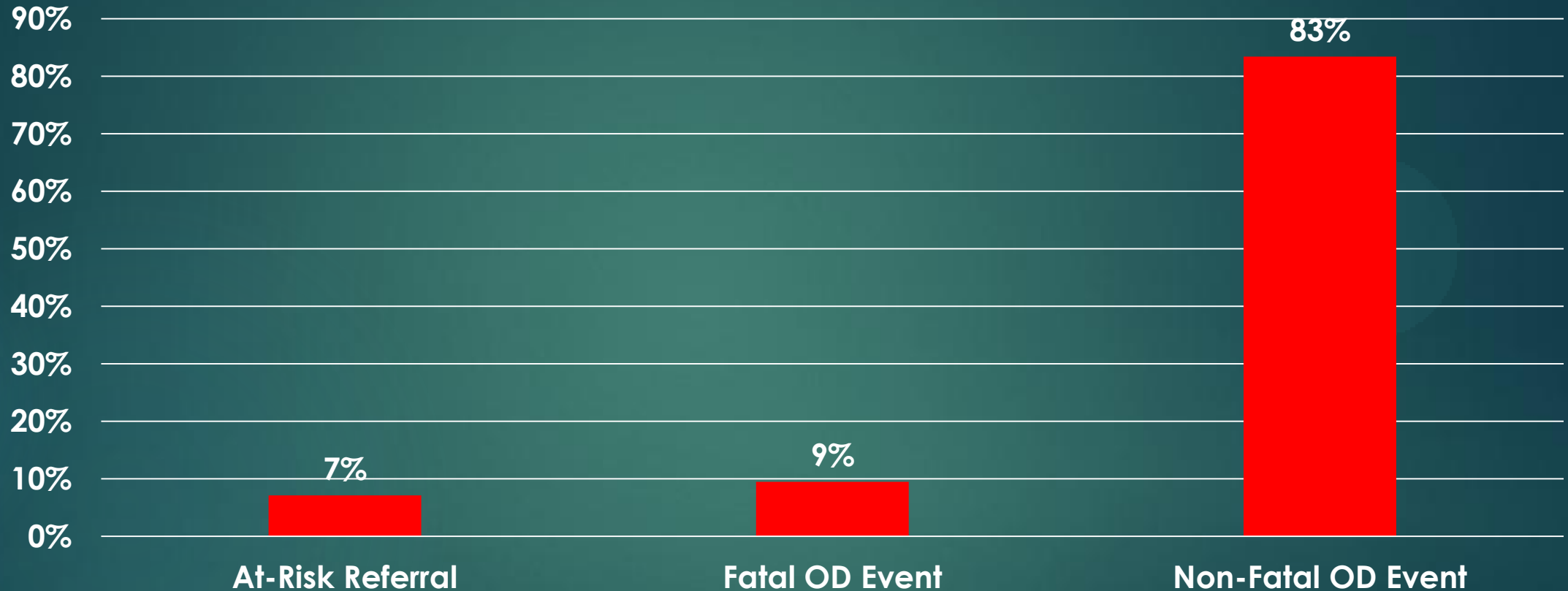
Type of Incident: North v. South

1/1/18 – 3/31/18



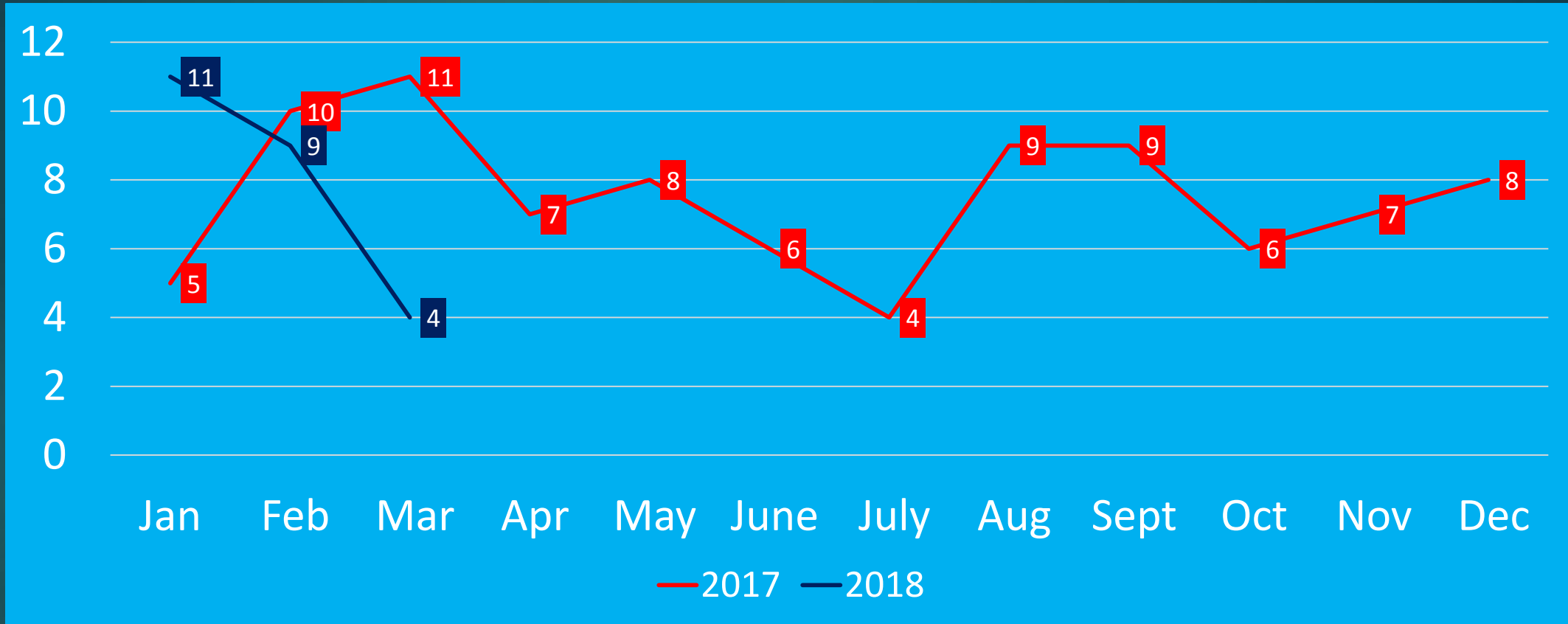
There were a total of **395 overdose incidents** reported in the county between 1/1/18 and 3/31/18 as recorded in the PCO database. **Thirty-six percent (142)** of these occurred in the “Southern” district and **64% (253)** occurred in the “North”.

Type of Incident: North District 1/1/18 – 3/31/18



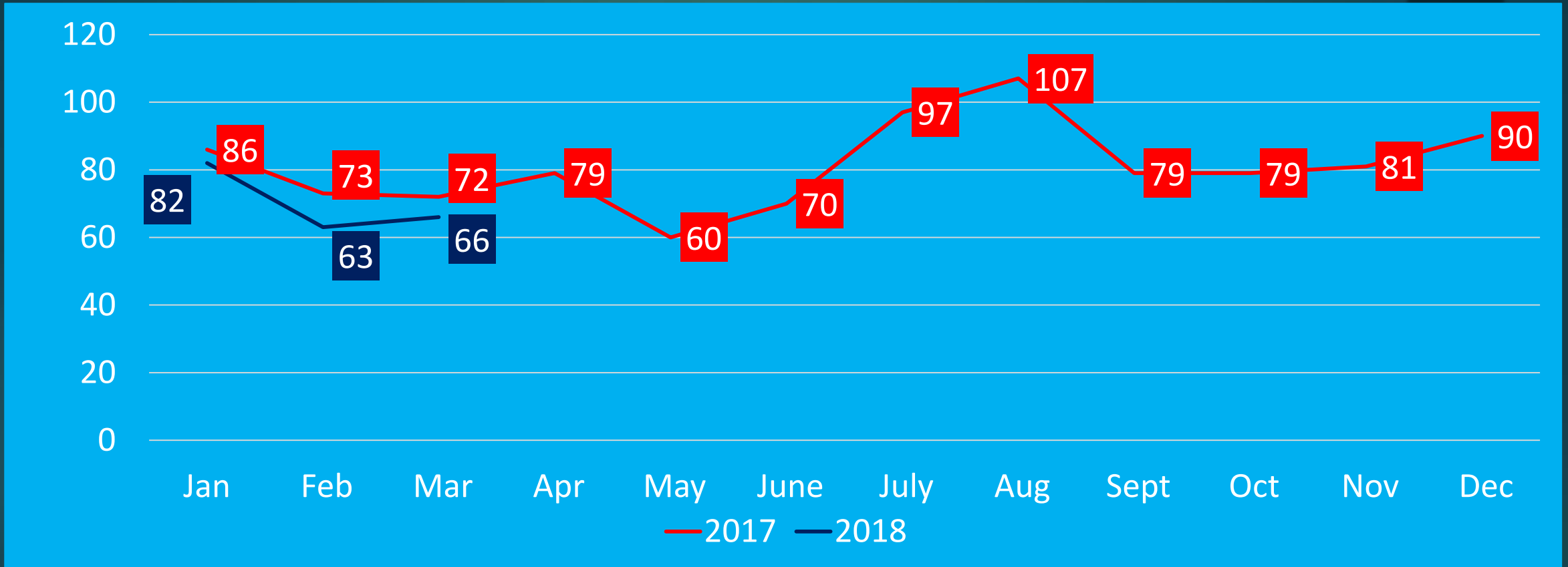
There were a total of **253 overdose incidents** recorded in the “North” district between 1/1/18 and 3/31/18: **24 (9%) were fatal**; **211 (83%) were non-fatal**; and **18 (7%)** were categorized as “at-risk” individuals.

Fatal Incident Monthly Trend: North



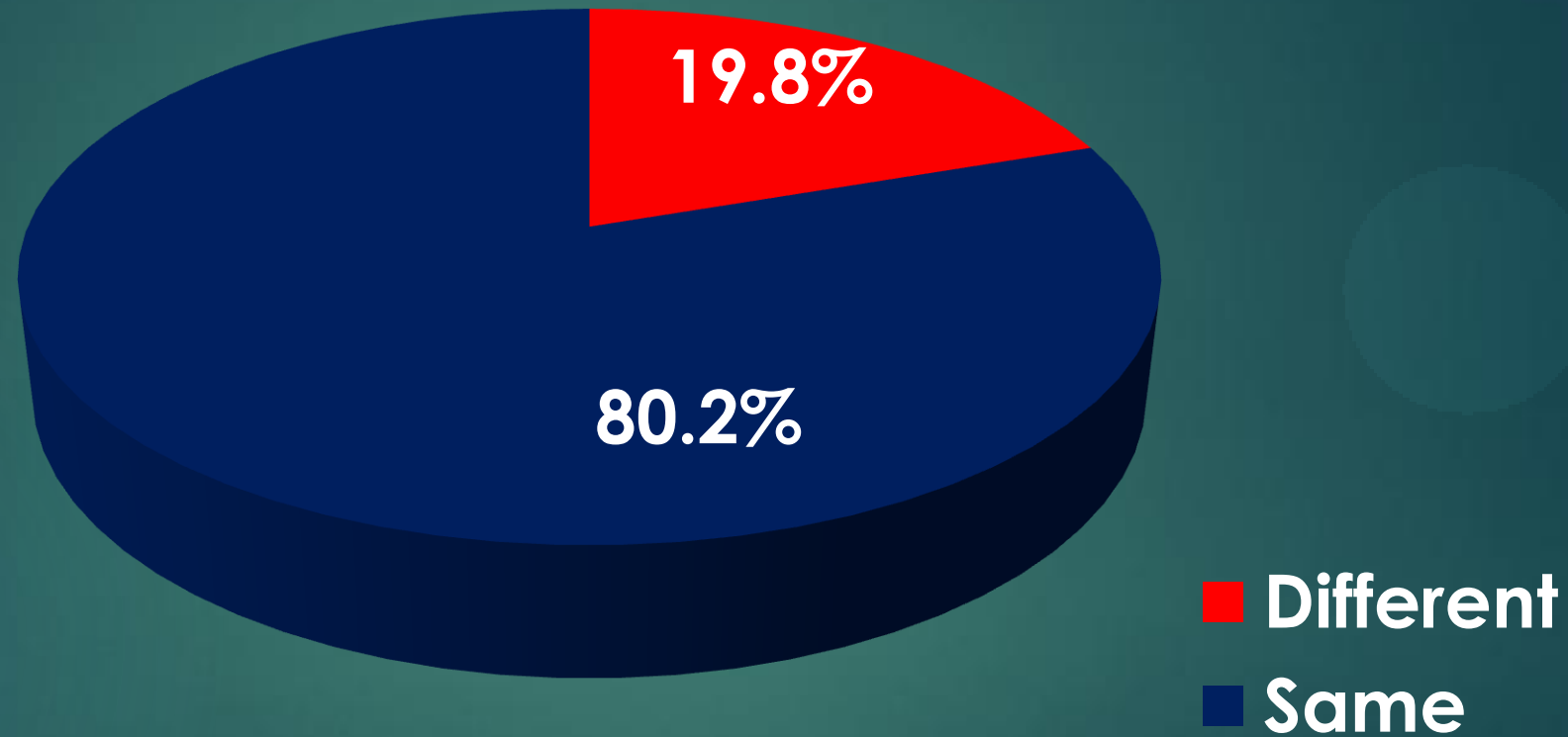
There has been on average **8 fatal ODs per month** in the “North” district so far 2018. This is slightly lower than the 8.6 average during this same time frame in 2017. There has been a steady decline in fatal overdoses so far in 2018

Non-Fatal Incident Monthly Trend: North



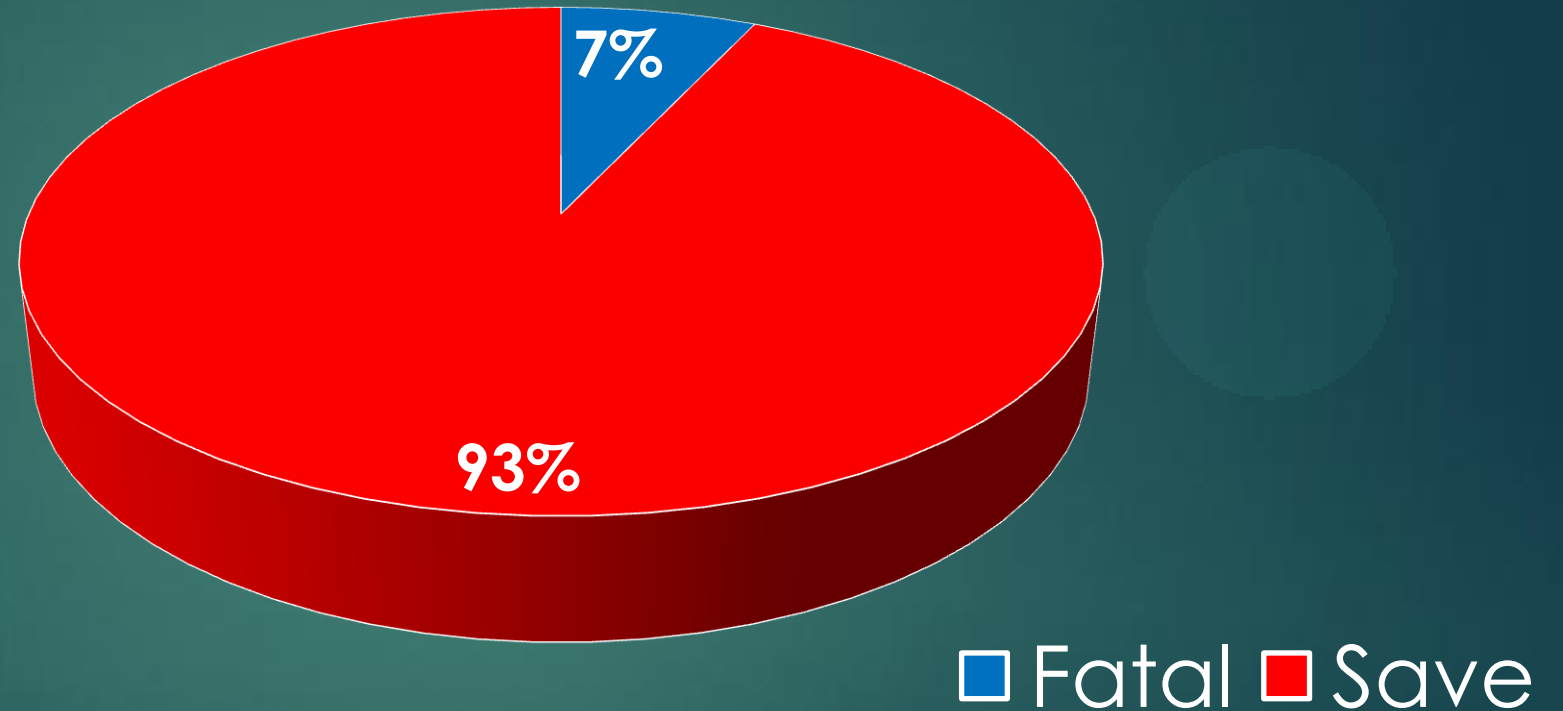
There has been on average **70 non-fatal ODs per month** in the “North” district so far 2018. This is an **9% decrease** from the average **77 per month** during this same time frame in 2017.

Incident vs. Resident Town: North (1/1/18 – 3/31/18)



In **203 incidents (80%)**, the individual with Substance Use Disorder resided in same town that the incident occurred. However, in **50 (20%)** of the incidents the person was from a different town than where the incident occurred.

Naloxone “Saves”: North (1/1/18 – 3/31/18) (n=152 Naloxone Admin)



Naloxone was administered in **152 (60%)** of the reported incidents. Ninety-two percent (141) of these events were non-fatal, while 8% (11) of these overdoses resulted in a fatality.
