WHAT ARE OPIOIDS?

CENTRAL NERVOUS SYSTEM DEPRESSANTS, PAIN RELIEVERS; HIGHLY ADDICTIVE

COMMONLY PRESCRIBED OPIOIDS:

VICODIN, OXYCODONE, CODEINE, MORPHINE, FENTANYL

OTHER OPIOIDS:

METHADONE, BUPRENORPHINE, HEROIN

WHAT ARE BENZODIAZEPINES?

MEDICATION COMMONLY PRESCRIBED FOR ANXIETY & INSOMNIA

COMMONLY PRESCRIBED BENZODIAZEPINES:

Ativan, Klonopin, Librium, Valium, Xanax

- •Inform your doctor of all medications that you are taking.
- •DO NOT MIX MEDICATIONS OR DRINK ALCOHOL.
 - •DO NOT TAKE MORE THAN PRESCRIBED.
 - •NEVER TAKE MEDS NOT PRESCRIBED.
 - •Tolerance increases the longer medication is taken.

LOCK UP prescription MEDICATIONS

IF YOU HAVE UNUSED, UNWANTED, EXPIRED MEDS—BRING THEM TO YOUR LOCAL POLICE DEPARTMENT'S DROP BOX.

OVERDOSE PREVENTION

KNOW THE SIGNS

- ♦ Blue lips or finger tips
- ◆ Breathing is slow, stopped or erratic— Gurgling snore
 - ♦ FOAMING AT THE MOUTH &/OR THROWING UP
 - ◆ PERSON WILL NOT RESPOND TO STIMULATION.

IF YOU SUSPECT SOMEONE IS OVERDOSING, CALL 911.

The Good Samaritan Law protects you!

WHILE YOU WAIT:

PERFORM RESCUE BREATHING



Make sure nothing is in the mouth.

Tilt head back, lift chin, pinch nose.

3

Breathe in mouth once every 5 seconds.







4 Administer Naloxone if you have it
